

Element 109 NKU

A revolution in church audio experience never heard or seen before!

Element 109 is a new church sound system that will change the way minister preach and how worship leaders lead. In a stunning new break though, it was discovered that biometric tagging had uses that are unique to the church community.

Imagine a new wireless mic system that requires no microphone, transmitter or batteries that loose power. All that a minister or worship leader has to do is step on a custom made carpet and the talk. Let the Element 109 system do the rest.



Any digital device was able to pick up the Element 109 broadcasts when these people came within 3 meters of each other.

This alarmed the Banks and Credit card Companies. Element 109 chips were transmitting passwords and critical sensitive data when the employees think about their work. The problem of security was not limited to lower staff members. All levels of corporate staff members were giving out their secret passwords and access codes while

working on any computer. The whole project was soon abandoned and put in mothball history..

This technology is for the audience too. When you are in the pews, you will be able to hear all of the spoken words a minister slurs, or when the minister does not speak loud enough for a conventional microphone. Element 109 is the most effective way to have worship that is so clear, the acoustics of a worship space has no impact on the sound. You could say it is impervious to acoustical nightmares.

Recently a professor Akin Spladen from MIT acquired the technology to see if there were other ways to implement this inventive system. It was discovered that these same microchips with element 109 NKU could be used as a patch instead of being injected into soft tissue. Professor Spladen discovered that wetting the microchip with an electrolyte or glucose based liquids activated and powered up the



The technology not new but recent human testing has raised new ways for its use.

The core of the technology starts with the use of those microchips used for tracking pet dogs and cats. For years veterinarians have been injecting pets with microchips to help animals to be recovered when they get lost. Whenever a pet is found, a scanner is passed over the animals back. The scanning action activates the microchip. This system picks up the transmitting code from the pet and the pet is returned to the owners. In this for the chip has limited information such as the owner name, address and when the pet was vaccinated for rabies.



broadcasting circuit. It literally happened over spilt coffee. Legend has it that the Professor place a microchip on a napkin lying on a lunch table. He had just used the napkin to wipe sweat off his forehead when colleague split coffee on the table. The napkin absorbed enough moisture that the electrolytes in his sweat were enough to

power up the microchip and start flashing message on personal Soft P4 PDA. It was at that point the term WetPatch™ was trademarked.

Recently an un-named credit card company and several banks were tests a variation of those animal microchips in humans. Element 109 was added to some of those chips before they were injected into soft tissue where it was thought that the chips could not move. Some chips were displaced and travel close to the spinal cord area. Soon afterwards it was discovered that Element 109 not only boosted the output of those microchips but it was broadcast banking information to any near by digital devices. Computers, PDA and digital day planners were receiving their secret information.

The WetPatch™ discovery soon came under the development of The Biblical Worship International group, a Non Profit group that started funding the system for further development. After several months of research and hundreds of prototypes a working system was perfected.



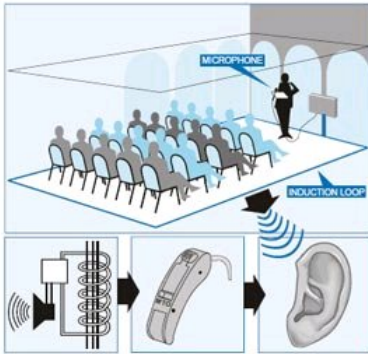
Here is how the WetPatch™ Element 109NKU system works. It starts when the patch is placed on the side of a preacher's neck, just below and slightly back of the ear. It allows your voice to be broadcasted without the use of a microphone of any kind. The patches are for one use only and are sold in packages of 50. Patches come in various flesh colors to match your



complexion or custom made with church logos, watermarks or embossed.

The patch has allowed for the development of new cut edge reflex technology. Mounted next to the microchip is an impact suppression circuit that limits the concussive sounds of coughing, sneezing or eustachian tube spasms. These sounds are instantly muted to a dull roar to prevent sudden bursts of sounds that can cause tympanic membrane damage. During pre testing of the patch, it was discovered that the nerves behind the ears have a burst of synaptic activity just before a sneeze or cough. The reflex device is a chip that is half the size of the Element 109 microchip. It is connected through body fluid sweat that is created under the water proof patch. The patch is shaped to ensure that ever time you put on an Element 109 patch, a part of the suppression circuit of the **patch fits over the coughing nerve.

The innovations don't stop there. By using another older 1950's technology – the wired loop system – a wire loop is taped to the underside of a rug and connected to a high powered transmitter. The transmitter then broadcasts the



voice sounds via RF to the audience members who are wearing WetPatch™ Glasses. The glass frame vibrates at ultra high frequencies that are strong enough to excite the bones in the ear canal that allow us to hear.

For the spoken portion of a worship service the WetPatch™ and glasses are you needed. When you

add music to the worship service, the same Element 109 system is used and supplemented with a traditional sound system. All musical instruments are electrified and played as usual. The conventional sound system works as before however, a patch converter at the live sound mixer desk is used to covert the microchip sounds to electro mechanical sounds without any concerns for feedback our intelligibility loss. When the singers sing, some of their sounds are being broadcasted through a traditional sound system while other parts of the voice range are broadcasted to the WetPatch™ glasses. On the sides of the glass frames are a digital delay control that allows each person to synchronize to the live sound system with an intuitive delay system. Once set, the

delay changes automatically as you move around the room. The only known side effect to the system is when people do not take a moment or two to adjust for the time delay. It leaves some people slightly disoriented after prolonged use.



Element 109 NKU Glasses come in four styles and several colors. His and Hers adult glasses and His and Hers children glasses. The glasses will work up to 5 hours on a single charge. The glasses are sealed in a single poured model frame. The

frames are designed to protect the wearer from shock or from interfering with hearing aids. For those people with older style

hearing aids with "T" switches a WetPatch™ neck loop is available. The glasses are made with porous tips. The eyeglasses are activated by watering both porous ear tips. If water is not available, saliva can be used. After using the glasses they can be recharged in an eyeglass sterilizing re-charger.

Transmission range of the WetPatch™ is over 1000 meters but can be contained within spaces that are lined with Canadian Gypsum board #5-8th. For glass windows, transparent lead plastic sheeting is recommended.



These glasses and WetPatches™ have the newest security codes created by the FAB agency that prevents any block of numbers larger than 7 digits or have sequences that can be related to banking or computer passwords.

The National Health Board or North America has asked for a warning label to be added to all Element 109 Systems stating that using the WetPatch™ for more than 5 hours or when

passing a computer and the patch dried up, personal thoughts can be broadcasted to MS Word Software in exact detail. Test samples of the patches can be ordered by churches to see if any person has rashes or other allergic reactions to wearing a water proof patch for extended periods of time. The church community is the only licensed user for the Element 109 systems. Although the UN's New World Order tried to secure the system for national security, the trademarks and Patents were already approved and granted by North American Trade Union. All systems are installed and monitored by the FAB agency. Those using the system for other than church use will be in breach of the Homeland FAB agency and will be prosecuted to the fullest extend of the law.



The WetPatches™ have security measures to prevent counterfeiting or recycling. Although Element 109 a fusion isotope, it has a half life of 20 milliseconds when exposed to air. It is unknown if the container will have any long term environment hazards. For your peace of mind, WetPatches™ come with a self mailing envelop to be mailed for safe disposal. Element 109 patches are deemed safe if placed in any other part of the body but once it is removed, it ceases to work.
